This Indenture made and entered into the 19th of June in year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty eight between William Turner and Rebecca his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of Botsey of the one part and William Harris of the same County and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Turner and Rebecca his wife for and in consideration of the sum of sixty dollars to them in hand paid by the said William Harris the Receipt is hereby acknowledged have granted and sold and confirmed unto the said William Harris his heirs or assigns forever certain tract of land containing by estimation thirty five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a Spanish Oak in William Harris and Mathias Weller line thence along said Weller line which being the run of the branch to the Cypress Swamp thence down the Cypress Swamp to a Black Gum corner two in William Harris line thence along the said Harris line to the first station together with all the appurtenances to the said tract of land and promise to have and to hold the same unto the said William Harris to him and his heirs forever and the said William Turner and Rebecca his wife doth by these presents grant to and under the said William Harris that they will warrant and defend all right title claim or demand to that same or any part thereof In Witness Whereof the said William Turner and Rebecca his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the
