 Beaton of the same County and State Members of the Methodist Protestant Church at
 Bethesda in the said County of Southampton Witnesseth that the said Edward Beaton
 and Mariah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four dollars to them in
 hand paid by the said Joseph W. Clark Joseph I. Pike and Edward Beaton the
 trustees aforesaid at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged and they the said Edward Beaton and Mariah
 his wife have given granted conveyed sold and by these presents do and each
 of them do hereby grant bargain sell unto the said Joseph W. Clark Joseph I. Pike
 and Edward Beaton Members of the Methodist Protestant Church at Bethesda in the
 County of Southampton aforesaid to their heirs forever a certain piece or parcel of
 land situated lying and being in the said County bounded as follows Beginning
 at a point on the Road in said Beaton's lot thence to a Stake given recently by
 them to a Stake twenty yds thence to a post standing twenty yds thence along
 the Road to the first Stake twenty yds containing not more nor a less I DO HAVE
AND TO HOLD the said lot piece or parcel of Land situated and bounded as
 aforesaid together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments improvements and
 appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way appertaining unto the said Joseph
 W. Clark Joseph I. Pike Edward Beaton and to their successors in Office forever upon
 brief Recital that the said Trustees and their successors duly appointed according
 to the Constitution and discipline of the said Methodist Protestant Church by the Major
 Members of the said Society at Bethesda in the said County of Southampton shall hold
 the said Land premises hereby conveyed in Trust for the use and benefit of the Members
 of the said Society of the Methodist Protestant Church at Bethesda in the said County
 of Southampton and to use the same for a purpose whatever AND the said Edward Beaton
 his wife do hereby covenant to and with the said Joseph W. Clark Joseph I. Pike and Edward
 Beaton and their successors in Office that they have and assign that for the said Edward
 Beaton his wife will warrant the title against all persons whomsoever IN WITNESS WHEREOF
the said Edward Beaton and Mariah his wife and the said Joseph W. Clark Joseph I. Pike
and Edward Beaton the trustees aforesaid have hereunto set their hands and seal
