THIS INDENTURE made the eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred eighty eight between John B. Jenkins & Margaret his wife of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one party and Domyng Johnson of the County and State aforesaid of the other party witnesseth that the said John B. Jenkins & Margaret his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty dollars in hand paid by the said Domyng Johnson at and before the making and delivery of this present instrument whereof a copy acknowledge they the said John B. Jenkins & Margaret his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do convey and of whom with grant bargain and sell unto the said Domyng Johnson his heirs and assigns all their undivided interest rights and title in and to the tract of Land whereof the said Mr Johnson doth now and proprietory containing One hundred and Ninety two acres more or less it being the undivided interest of Plaintiff Jenkins one of the heirs and devisees of the said Archibald Johnson Esq; and which was conveyed by the said Jordan Johnson to John B. Jenkins by virtue of bargain and sale as will appear by reference to the Records of Southampton County the said tract of land adjoins the lands of Archibald Howell Jordan Edward James & Magenta relatives with all and singular the possession and cessions remainder and remainder yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof I do bear and to hold the aforesaid undivided interest in and to the said tract or parcel of Land unto the said Domyng Johnson his heirs and assigns forever and the said John B. Jenkins & Margaret his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land the undivided interest thereof as aforesigned unto the said Domyng Johnson his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of trust the said John B. Jenkins and Margaret his wife or either of them their or their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents John Bishop witness of the said John B. Jenkins & Margaret his wife have executed set their hands and seal the day & year as first above written.
