wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars to them
in hand paid before the writing and delivery of this present the receipt of which
being acknowledged they the said Simon Murfey and Lydia his wife have granted
bargained and sold unto and by their present grant bargain and sell to the said Richard
Barrett his heirs and assigns forever one half of the interest the several tracts of land
purchased of John W. Stephens by said Murfey Constituting what is commonly
called Franklin which well appear by referring to a certain deed recorded by
said Stephens and wife to Murfey and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of
this County bearing date the twelfth day of July in the year above mentioned To have
and to hold the said interest in said tract of Land with all the appurtenances
before mentioned unto the said Richard Barrett his heirs and assigns forever And
the said Simon Murfey and Lydia his wife for themselves and their heirs the said
interest in said Land with all the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said
