thousand eight hundred and forty eight between John Odoming and Elizabeth Odoming
his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and
Polly Kitchin of the aforesaid County and State of the second part Witnesseth
that the said John Odoming and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum
of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Polly Kitchin the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have given granted bargained and sold with full power given
grant bargain and sell to the said Polly Kitchin (as certain tract or parcel of Land
lying and situate in said County aforesaid containing by estimation forty seven acres
or there abouts more or less bounded by the Land of P. Kitchin on the North and West and
Polly Kitchin on the South and East To have and to hold to her within record
promise together with all appurtenances or advantages appertaining to the land and be the
said John Odoming and Elizabeth his wife do further covenant and agree to and with
the said Polly Kitchin that they will warrant and defend all the right title claim
or demand of any other person or persons whatsoever claiming by and through them to the
only use and behoof of her the said Polly Kitchin and to her heirs forever The Witness
whereof the said John Odoming and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands
and affixed their seals this day and year above written

This Indenture made and entered into this 3^d day of December in the year 1841 between
Abner S. Harrison of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and Pittsburg S Sme
of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the sum of seven hundred dollars good and lawful money in hand paid to the said
Abner S. Harrison by the said Pittsburg S Sme at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the said Abner S. Harrison hereby acknowledged the receipt thereof to the said
Pittsburg S Sme and do hereby grant bargain and sell with full power given
grant bargain and sell to the said Pittsburg S Sme (as certain tract or parcel of Land promise and improvements
and with his heirs forever The Witness whereof the said Pittsburg S Sme his heirs and assigns
through attachment or belonging with him the said Pittsburg S Sme his heirs and assigns
formerly being at last of Land purchased by A. Harrison of Sme Sme formerly being
to Henry Harrison containing by recent survey six hundred and fifty four acres be the
same more or less and bounded as follows to wit: Commencing at a corner tree in French
