WITNES John Barrett by his last Will and Testament which was admitted to
probate by the County Court of Southampton on the 21st day of November 1845 did among
other things say "My Will and desire is that my Negro man George be hired out
until his pay to my estate Two hundred dollars with interest thereon from my death
and that he go to and whereas the said George man George has paid to the estate
of the said John Barrett the sum of two hundred dollars with interest thereon
from the death of the said John Barrett". Now I now all men by their pounds that
James Magg Executor of the last Will and Testament of the said John Barrett doth
hereby remitteth to me my master and set free and by these presents to me myself
and set free the Negro slave George aforesaid and I do hereby declare him the said George
to be entirely liberated from said Slavery and entituled to all the rights and privileges &c
free person with which it is in my power to set him. for the said George is of
black complexion about four feet six inches high and about forty six years of age
In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the 11th
day of September 1848.
