Lawrence Whosoever the said Case Bares has hereunto set his hand and seal the 15th day of August 1848.

This Indenture made and executed this 11 day of Sept. A. D. one thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Everett Holladay and Ann his wife of Richmond Ct. of the first part and Case Bares of Southampton Ct. of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Everett Holladay and Ann his wife here for and in consideration of the sum of forty three dollars and twenty eight cents to them in hand paid by the said Case Bares the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell absolute in fee simple and confirm unto the said Case Bares his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract and parcel of land lying and being in Southampton Ct. near Black water river on the East side of the road from Case Holmes to E. and L. Depot containing by survey thirty 14 and a half acres bounded as follows: Beginning at a lightwood stump in the said road (a tree corner between the tract and Warrens Swamp thence 2.17 & 8 poles to run each thence 2.87 & 6.26 poles to a post Oak a corner of Warrens Swamp and the tract in Case Bares lot then 2.9 & 131 poles along a line of tract then between the tract and Case Bares to a short line a corner of the tract and a Landmark in the run of a small branch thence up the run of the said branch the various courses thereof 164 poles to the bridge over the aforesaid road near E. and L. Depot from another tree corner of the tract and Warrens Swamp thence 58 & 76 poles along the said road to the beginning. Witnesseth that the aforesaid premises with all the messuage and messuages and manors yearly and other rents forever: the said Everett Holladay and Ann his wife do hereby warrant and will forever defend the aforesaid premises free from all the claims or claims demand or demands of all and every person whatsoever.
