This Indenture made and entered into this 21st day of December one thousand eight hundred and forty seven between James M. Deleh Commission to a certain decree of the Chancery Superior Court at the Towne Court of Southampton County and State of Virginia directed to him as Commissioner of the first part and Marshal Esfor of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the Chancery and County Court of Law of Southampton County did order and decree that the Commissioner above named shall sell the Land in said decree mentioned and belonging to the heirs of Wiley E. Deleh with all of which will have fully appear by reference to the Records of the County of Southampton and by view and in presence of said decree the said James M. Deleh Commissioner as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty one dollars and 25 cts. to him the said James M. Deleh Commissioner as aforesaid hath granted bargain and sold and by their private deed grant bargain and sold to the said Marshal Esfor to her and to her heirs the tract and parcel of land hereinafter in said decree being the land called Willfords tract and lying and being in the County of Southampton containing One hundred and seven acres by the same more or less and bounded by Dehors road on the North Black water on the East Sarapin Swamp on the South and the main run of the deep branch to Sarapin Swamp on the West this being the dividing line between Joseph Deleh and the tract mentioned in said decree with very part and parcel thereof and to all its residue right heirs interest claim or demand of him the said James M. Deleh Commissioner in and to the said premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances thereto belonging and the said Marshal Esfor her heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of her the said Marshal Esfor and the said James M. Deleh Commissioner as aforesaid done for himself his heirs and the land and other the premises and every part thereof against himself his heirs shall and will forever defend by their private deed Witnesseth that the said James M.
