Shands shall after having given due notice of the time and place of sale by advertisement at the courthouse or proximus to sell at public auction to the highest bidder for cash the aforesaid personal and real estate and collect the money due from Martin B. Rockwell Executor of James Rockwell's exec and out of the money arising from the sale proceed to pay all the debts mentioned in the foregoing part of the deed and all debts to which Littleton R. Edwards is security but the debt due Martin Rockwell in three bushels amounting to between five and six hundred dollars to which Littleton R. Edwards Nicholsen in Rockwell and Fred A. Spark of which nothing is to be paid until in fact of land known as Rockwells place is sold and the money arising from that sale or so much thereof as the debt permits to be applied to the payment of the said Martin Rockwell lands they having been agreed to be paid along with other debts by virtue of trust upon the said tract of lands and the balance of money if any pay over to the said Saml P. This OBLIGATION made and entered into the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 1848 between Littleton R. Edwards and John M. Lurley Executor of William A. Spark etc. of the first part James D. Mapenburg administrator of James Mapenburg etc. assignee of Alfred Rich of the second part and James W. Kinslow of the third part William R. Edwards and others A. Spark by his deed dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 1845 and admitted to record in the Clerks Office of Southampton County on the said 29<sup>th</sup> day of November 1848 is made effectually to secure the payment of four thousand three hundred and twenty two dollars & seven cents due by said payables to Alfred Rich Esquire of Elizabethtown District being unto the said Littleton R. Edwards in trust & custome but as part of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing by estimation six hundred and thirty and what ever more or less land by the Lands of James D. Mapenburg the Lands of the estate of James Scott Mapenburg Mapenburg and Alfred Kinslow and all and singular the premises and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of Land and premises belonging or in any way appertaining until the said sum of four thousand three hundred and twenty two dollars and seven cents having been transferred by the said Alfred Rich to James D. Mapenburg in his lifetime and which since his death has come to the hands of James D. Mapenburg his attorney and has been paid off by John M. Lurley Executor of William A. Spark and
