This Indenture made the 11th day of October 1848 between Samuel P. Nicholas of the first part, E. W. Mapham of the second part, Martha Kellhorn & R. Edwards Sons, Agent Henry Blunt Horner & D. Mott, Charles & Pepp & D. D. Clark and all other persons securities for and creditors of the said Nicholas of the third part. Whereas the said Nicholas is greatly indebted and wishes so far as it is in his power to toward from left in the first place all persons who may be his securities Charles & Pepp & D. D. Clark and in the second place all his creditors who have no security. And whereas doubt had arisen whether the same now about to be conveyed were or were not included in a deed executed by the said Nicholas on the 26th of September 1848 and now of Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County. And this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promises and the further consideration of one dollar to the said Nicholas in hand paid by the said E. W. Mapham at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Nicholas has given granted bargained and sold and by these presents does give grant bargain and sell to the said E. W. Mapham his heirs and assigns forever the following slave to wit "Dick, Albert, Saml, Jimmy and ten future increase" to have and to hold the said slave to him the said E. W. Mapham his heirs and assigns upon Trust nevertheless that the said Nicholas may be permitted to remain in quiet possession of the same until such time as some of the persons intended to be benefited by this Indenture shall request the same to be sold and then upon this further Trust that so soon after such request as he may think proper the said E. W. Mapham shall proceed to sell the said slave to the highest bidder for cash after having fixed the time and place of sale at his own discretion and given notice thereof at the Court house or at two or more public places; and out of the money arising from such sale shall after satisfying the charge thereof and all other expenses attending the premises pay in the first place all debts due from the said Nicholas for which any person may be his security including one to Martha Kellhorn or which P. R. Edwards & J. M. Fehrell are securities and then debts in which there is no security one due Martha Kellhorn of \$240 one due Clark & Pepp one due D. D. Clark amount not recollecting the debt above mentioned to be paid pro rata of the fund should fall short and in the second place all debts due from the said Nicholas or which there is no security to be paid pro rata and the balance of any sum due to the said Nicholas his heirs Executors and administrators the which through the said parties have hereto set their hands and affixed their seals the day's year above written
