the said Robert Russell by deed dated the 15th March 1847 and attested
to Record on the same day in the Clerk's Office of said County in order to secure
the payment of the sum of \$230 owing by the said Robert Russell to the said
Harriet D. Pope as aforesaid and the further sum of \$201 which sum was
first secured by deed of Trust in personal property to said parties and assigned
as the first mortgage in Trust to the said John A. Lusk (a distant tract or parcel
of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing 180 acres more or less
and the sum of \$230 having been fully paid by the said Robert Russell
to the said Harriet D. Pope as aforesaid and the sum of \$201 fully satisfied
to her as the mortgagee in the Land is concerned by the said Harriet D. Pope as
aforesaid hath requested that the estate conveyed by the said deed of Trust
to her the said John A. Lusk in the said tract of Land be now released to
her the said Robert Russell This Indenture therefore Witnesseth that for
and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of it

aforesaid signified by the being a party hereto have mutually released and
forever quit and claim unto the said Robert Russell his heirs and assigns forever
all the estate right title interest property claim or demand whatsoever in Law or
equity of him or unto the aforesaid 180 acres of Land with its appurtenances to
the said Robert Russell his heirs and assigns forever so that the said John A.
Lusk and his heirs have any other person whatsoever claiming under him shall
