is justly indebted to the said Hasty Crop in the sum of five hundred and thirty
dollars and twenty eight cents as by his last booring date with the Interture which with
the lawful interest thereon occurring the said Charles A. Daugler is willing and
desire to secure "Now This Indenture witnesseth that for and in Consideration
of the premises and also for the further Satisfaction of the parties and also for the
further Consideration of one dollar to the said Charles A. Daugler in hand paid by
the said Wm. M. Jones at and before the enrolling and delivery of these presents he may
whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Charles A. Daugler hath given granted
borrowed and held received and Confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain
sell release and Confirm to the said Wm. M. Jones his heirs Executors administrators
for ever certain negroes now by the name of Nicks & Jacob To have and to hold
the before mentioned negro slaves unto the said Wm. M. Jones his heirs Executors and
Administrators upon Trust nevertheless that the said Wm. M. Jones shall as soon as he
can after default of payment of the debt aforesaid with the interest thereon occur
ing advertise the time and place of sale of the said negro slaves at the most
public places nearest the present residence of the said Charles A. Daugler
provided and sell the same to the highest bidder for for the last price that can be
obtained in cash and out of the monies rising from such sale first pay all the
necessary expenses attending the sale and then pay to the said Hasty Crop his heirs
Executors Administrators the debt and interest aforesaid and the balance if any be left
pay to the said Charles A. Daugler his heirs Executors and administrators "It is witness
