Now all men by these presents that I Robert T. Parker of the County of Southampton in consideration of forty dollars to me in hand paid by James & Peters of the said County the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said James & Peters his heirs and assigns a certain well located and situate swamp with fourteen acres of land more or less situate between lying on both sides of the said swamp, it being the well located and land belonging to my father Thomas T. Parker deceased, situate to me by the Commission bounded on the north by the lands of Thomas Parker deceased on the south by the land of the said James & Peters together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the said land and well in any wise appurtenant and belonging. I do hereby warrant to hold the above granted premises to the said James & Peters his heirs and assigns forever and I the said Robert T. Parker for myself my heirs Executors and administrators do covenant with the said James & Peters his heirs and assigns that I have lawfully received in fee of the before granted premises that they are free from all incumbrances; that I have a good and perfect right to sell and convey the same to the said James & Peters his heirs and assigns as aforesaid and that I will and my heirs Executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said James & Peters his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. Witnesseth that the said David Bryant for and in consideration of the sum of three dollars and six cents to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Drayton at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargain and sell and by these presents with grant bargain and sell unto the said Lewis Drayton his heirs and assigns forever a certain parcel or part of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton's parish of Saint Luke's containing by Survey one and three fourth acres be the land more or less and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at the forks of the river road in said Lewis Drayton's line thence along the line 24 1/2 25 1/2 poles to wit
