 forever all the right title interest claim or estate of whatsoever kind or character
 whether of Law or otherwise which she the said Margaret Taylor now or late
 or in equity hath or may hereafter have in and to that certain tract or parcel of
 Land which was conveyed by the said Barham Taylor her late husband of the
 said Margaret Taylor to the said Cuthbert D. Barham by deed bearing date
 in the day of A.D. 1853 and hereinafter referred and situated lying and
 being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia and for a
 particular description of which reference is here again made to the said deed
 from said Barham Taylor to said Cuthbert D. Barham or record in the
 Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton in the State of Virginia
 with all and singular the incidents and appurtenances therunto belonging
 or in any way appertaining and all the estate right title interest claim or
 demand whatever of her the said Margaret Taylor of in and to the said
 Land and premises and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold
 the said Land and premises above mentioned with every part and parcel thereof
 with the appurtenances unto the said Cuthbert D. Barham his heirs and
 assigns to the only proper and lawful heirs of the said Cuthbert D. Barham his
 heirs and assigns forever And the said Margaret Taylor for herself and
 her heirs the said Land and premises and every part and parcel thereof with
 all the estate right title and interest hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed
 therein against herself and her heirs and all and every other person or persons
 whatsoever claiming the same by through or under her will warrant and power
 granted to the said Cuthbert D. Barham and to his heirs and assigns. In
