This INDUMENT makes and intitutes into this 16th day of September in the
year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Nathan
Williams and Rebekah his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of
Nollaway of the one part and Elizabeth Draper of the same County and parish
of the other part witnesseth that the said Nathan Williams and Rebekah
his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars
Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Elizabeth Draper
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted Bargained sold and Conveyed
unto and by the present to grant Bargain and sell unto the said Elizabeth
Draper to her and her heirs and assigns forever two certain tracts of Land on
either side of the Road West of the town of New Haven containing thirty acres to the same
more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a small Red Oak at
the Road in Arlington Barrows less than along a line of Marketed trees to
a white Oak @ corner less on the Garrison line to @ pine @ corner less on side
Barrows and furnish Chappell line thence along sd Chappell line to the Road
thence up the Road to the first station the other tract containing twenty nine
acres more or less both tracts together making one hundred and one acre the party
tract bounded as follows to wit beginning at @ pine in John D. Johnson's land
William Davis line thence along Davis line to @ pine at the head of @ branch
in sd Davis line thence the run of sd Branch to the Mill pond thence down
the Mill pond to @ branch adjoining John D. Johnson's line up said branch to
the first station together with all houses out houses offices buildings gates gardens
orchards ways waters and water course whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining
to the said tract or parcel of Land and premises to have and to hold the same
unto the said Elizabeth Draper to her and her heirs forever and the said Nathan
Williams and Rebekah his wife shall by their present grant to and unto the said
Elizabeth Draper that they will warrant and defend all right title claims
demands to the same or any part thereof I W. D. Davis wherof the said Nathan
Williams and Rebekah his wife have countersigned at this house and affixed thereto
