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This Indenture made and executed the first day of August one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight between Henry Dunford of the first and Richard Bayle of the second part both of Bedford County North Carolina Witnesseth that the said Henry Dunford and Sophia Ann his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargain and sold and by these presents bargain and sell alienate and convey unto the said Richard Bayle his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by estimation one hundred and sixty two acres be the same more or less adjoining the lands of Richard M^r H. J. Smith Williams W. H. H. the Black Water River it being the nor half of a tract of land Sect Darden's Manor his wife gave to him and Sophia Darden in the year 1817 To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with the messuages & ornaments & ornaments & appurtenances thereto unto the said Richard Bayle his heirs and assigns forever the said Henry Dunford and Sophia Ann his wife do hereby warrant and will forever defend the aforesaid promise unto the said Richard Bayle his heirs and assigns forever from the claim demand or demands of all and every person whatsoever In Testimony whereof the said Henry Dunford and Sophia Ann his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year aforesaid Signed sealed acknowledged and delivered in presence of
