This Indenture made and entered into on the day of October in the year of our last eight hundred and forty eight between Davis Bregant of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Elijah Sagers of the same County and State of the other part "Witnesseth" that the said Davis Bregant for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars and sixty five cents to him in hand paid by the said Elijah Sagers at and before the making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both grantor bargainor and also and by their private deed grant bargain and sell unto him the said Elijah Sagers his heirs and assigns forever one certain piece or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke containing by a later survey three and one fourth acres (to the same more or less) and bounded as follows to wit "Beginning in the old road near Davis Donnell gate in said Elijah Sagers land thence he laid along the old Road 88 E 64 poles to the fork of the old and new Road near said Sagers Store thence along the new Road S 20 3/4 W 54 1/2 poles to Davis Donnell his corner in said Road thence his line N 87 W 20 poles to the beginning To have and to hold the above described piece or parcel of Land and its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Elijah Sagers his heirs and assigns forever and the said Davis Bregant for himself his heirs executors administrators and assigns Command and agreed to and with the said Elijah Sagers his heirs executors administrators and assigns that he will by their private warrant forever defend all the right and title of the above described piece or parcel of Land against the claim or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever" In Witness whereof the said Davis Bregant hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day even first above written signed sealed & delivered
