This INDENTURE Made and entered into this 30<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1848  
by and between Postscript D. Custer of the first part Jonathan Griffon  
of the second part and Jacob Banus of the third and last part all of us  
parties of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia This Indenture  
Witnesseth that the said Postscript D. Custer is owing to the said Jacob Banus  
the sum of two hundred dollars which sum will be due on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December  
year 1850 A.M. Whereas the said Custer is willing to pay the payment of  
the said sum also the legal interest of any that may accrue thereon as well  
as all costs which shall accrue in consequence of the Indenture up to the  
full execution thereof Now therefore will in consideration of the further sum  
of one dollar in hand paid by the said J. S. Griffon at the making and delivery  
of this present the Receipt of which is acknowledged by the said Postscript D.  
Custer in consideration of the fulfillment of the purpose above named having  
and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said J. S.  
Griffon his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land  
lying in the said County of Southampton containing one hundred and  
sixty six acres of Land by the said James Jacob Banus having the above named  
day and date executed to the said Postscript D. Custer @ doth in writing  
the boundaries thereof will fully appear by referring to the said deed for  
said Banus to said Custer for him the said J. S. Griffon \$30 HOURS AND  
to hold all the right title interest and estate of and in to the said Land and  
appurtenances to the said Land belonging or in any way appertaining from the  
date hereof forward but in trust nevertheless that it is to say if the said  
Postscript D. Custer or any other person or his behalf shall at any time break  
and before the payment of said sum of two hundred and Ninety dollars together  
with the interest which shall have accrued and costs as aforesaid shall  
be required by the said Jacob Banus his executors administrators or assigns provided  
that of two hundred and Ninety dollars the account interest and cost as of now  
that shall and in that case by the said J. S. Griffon shall remain all the right  
title interest and estate hereby granted in Trust for the purpose before named  
but in case the said sum of two hundred and Ninety dollars with the said  
interest cost as aforesaid be not paid over before demand being made as aforesaid  
it shall as herein purposed be lawful and not only so but the sum of
