This Indenture made and entered into the 24th day of Nov^r 1848 between John
 & Squire of the first part, John Backman of the second part, and B. & N. P. Pope of
 the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia whereas the said
 John & Squire is indebted to the said Backman & Pope by bond bearing date the
 24th day of Nov^r 1848 in the sum of fifteen dollars and fifty cents and being
 indebted to the said Back & Pope by said bearing date the 18th day of August 1848
 in the sum of five dollars forty cents and the said Squire being also
 indebted to the said B. & N. P. Pope by said bearing date the 24th day of Nov^r 1848
 in the sum of forty three dollars & 3/4th and the said John & Squire being willing
 and desirous to secure the aforesaid debts and interest now this Indenture Witnesseth
 that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of one
 dollar to him the said John & Squire in hand paid by the said John Backman
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged, the said John & Squire hath given granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell to the said John
 Backman his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit: his present crop
 corn and fodder and hay house right now head of hogs and other future increase and
 horse cart and wheels and gear and gig and harness two ploughs four four ploughs his
 four milch cows two beds and furniture one clock one iron stove one chest with all other
 crockery ware six sitting chairs all farming implements all his house hold kitchen
 furniture so have and to hold to him the said John Backman proper
 and behoof forever upon Trust notwithstanding that the said John Backman shall at
 the request of either or of the aforesaid parties after giving at least ten days notice
 the time and place of sale sell at public auction all the property herein named
 or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to satisfy said debts and interest and out
 of the proceeds first pay the expenses thereof then pay the debts aforesaid with
 interest and the balance if any pay over to the said John & Squire or his legal
 representatives and the said John & Squire covenants with the said John Backman
 that he is possessed of an absolute free simple right to all the property herein
 named and that he will forever defend and defend the same against himself
 and all other persons whatsoever In witness whereof we and each of us have
