This Indenture made and entered into this 25th September 1848 between Catharine Dregon of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Nancy Whiting of the second part and William Whiting of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Catharine Dregon is indebted to the said Nancy Whiting in the sum of about hundred and fifty eight dollars and twenty cents half full money of the State of Virginia with interest from the date hereof and whereas the said Catharine Dregon is willing and desirous effectually to secure the said Nancy Whiting in the premises This Indenture therefore Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to be the said William Whiting in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged her bargain and sell and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto and confirm unto the said William Whiting his heirs and assigns forever the following real and personal property to wit: My right and interest in all the Negro given to me by my deceased Father David Whiting dead and all the property I may be entitled to from the success and the money I expect to get for my school To have and to hold the said property unto the sd William Whiting his heirs and assigns forever But upon the special trust that the said William Whiting his heirs shall above
