

This Indenture made and entered into on the 22nd day of March eighteen hundred and thirty six between John R. Bryant and Priscilla his wife of this part and Mike Cook of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said James D. Bryant John R. Bryant and Priscilla Bryant his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and twenty five dollars current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Mike Cook at or before the enrolling and sealing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and make of them unto the said Mike Cook all his unpossessed and unexpired land lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke containing by a late survey Ninety Two acres to the same more or less with the exception (that is to say) of the Meadows temporal of Bryant's which was allotted to her the said lot is to hold in quiet possession during her life and it being a part of the tract of Land formerly owned by James Taylor and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a White Oak a corner for said Mike Cook in Williamson line thence along said line S 55 E 69 poles to a pine tree S 45 E 15 poles to an Oak tree S 46 W 39 poles to a small post oak thence S 5 W 80 poles to the run of swamp thence down the Run of said swamp to a Gaggenow line N 20 W 116 poles to the Head of the Adams Branch at Corwin's Oldfield Smith line thence up said Branch along said Smith's line of Market trees to a Rock corner or corner for said Mike Cook thence along his line S 54 E 6 156 poles to the first Market together with all right title interest claim or demand of me and to the above described Land and premises with its appurtenances there belonging or in any wise appertaining to him and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances there belonging unto him the said Mike Cook his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose and intent of him the said Mike Cook his heirs and assigns forever until the said James D. Bryant John R. Bryant and Priscilla his wife for whom their heirs executors administrators and assigns to do and make of them unto the said Mike Cook his heirs and assigns that they will by their present warrant and former default sue Right and title to the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises and may seek a writ of distress against the claim or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever to the Sheriff whereof the said James D. Bryant John R. Bryant and Priscilla his wife heirs executors administrators and assigns their seal the day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered.
