

This Indenture made and entered into this the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 1848  
 between William B Howell and Ann R his wife and Mary A Pond of the County  
 of Sussex of the first part and James Foreman of the County of Southampton of  
 the second part all of the State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said William B  
 Howell and Ann R his wife and Mary A Pond as holding or wife as shown for  
 and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars of lawful money  
 of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said James Foreman at or before the  
 making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said  
 James Foreman his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and  
 being in the County of Southampton containing four hundred and forty four acres  
 or the same more or less and is bounded as follows to wit "on the west by Thomas  
 Hart on the south by Andrew on the east by Alfred Briddle on the north by  
 Isaac Cook Swamp together with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto  
 belonging or in any way appertaining unto the said James Foreman his heirs and  
 assigns forever unto the said William B Howell and Ann R his wife and Mary  
 A Pond for themselves and their heirs do bargain and sell the said tract or parcel  
 of Land with all its appurtenances above mentioned unto the said James Foreman  
 his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim of the said William B  
 Howell and Ann R his wife and Mary A Pond or any other person or persons who  
 will warrant and favor defend by these presents and Witnesseth that the said  
 William B Howell and Ann R his wife and Mary A Pond have hereunto set  
 their hands and seals this day and year first in this Indenture written

Pupae County To wit Wm William H Dugan and James B Hill Justices  
 of the peace in the County aforesaid in the State of Virginia do hereby certify that  
 William B Howell and Ann R his wife and Mary A Pond Witnesses of their  
 said parties to a certain deed bearing date the 26<sup>th</sup> October 1848 and heretofore  
 approved personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid and acknowledged the  
 same to be their act and deed. And the said Ann R Howell wife of the said  
 William B Howell being warned by a private and apart from her husband and  
 having the said aforesaid fully explained to her the said Ann R acknowledged  
 the same to be her act and deed and declared that she had willingly signed  
 and delivered the said and that she wished not to retract it. And the said  
 William B Howell & Mary A Pond acknowledged the aforesaid deed to be their  
 act and deed in the County the said acknowledged to the Clerk of the  
 County Court of Southampton in the State of Virginia in order that the said  
 deed may be recorded. Given under our hands and seals the 26<sup>th</sup> day of
