This Indenture made the 1st day of 18th and thousand eight hundred and forty eight
 between Micajah Holleman of the County of Southampton of the first part and Jacob
 Williams of the said County of the second part Witnesseth that the said Micajah
 Holleman for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and twenty two
 dollars Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Jacob Williams
 the Receipt Whereof the said Micajah Holleman doth hereby acknowledge hath
 granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth give grant bargain
 sell and convey to the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns at certain tract
 or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing two hundred
 and fourteen acres and half by the said tract or lot and bounded as follows to wit
 Beginning at a small post Oak Corner for Samuel Pope and Micajah Holleman
 standing in William Byrnes line thence at line of Marked trees to the pond branch
 thence across the pond branch to a post thence down the West side of the said
 branch to a long tree standing near the Root of the bridge Branch a corner for
 Samuel Pope thence down the said bridge branch to a post standing in the Back
 line Swamp thence across the Back line Swamp to a post a corner for Micajah
 Holleman standing in Hills Current Estate line thence down the said Swamp to a
 white Oak a corner for Thomas Ridgely and Micajah Holleman thence a line of
 Marked trees across the said Swamp to small branch thence up the said branch
 to a Back line a corner for Thomas Ridgely and John Thompson Estate land and
 William Thomas William Byrnes line to the beginning containing two hundred and
 fourteen acres and half by the said tract or lot. To have and to hold to the
 said tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said
 Jacob Williams his heirs or assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said
 Jacob Williams his heirs or assigns forever and him the said Micajah Holleman
 for himself his heirs Executors and administrators doth hereby Covenant and
 to and with the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns that he the said
 Micajah Holleman and his heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with the
 appurtenances unto him the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns against the
 said Micajah Holleman and his heirs and against all persons whosesoever shall
 and will by those presents forever warrant and defend. In Witness Whereof
