

Will INDEMNITY. Made this 6<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty eight between Henry Morris and Elizabeth Morris his wife of the one part & Wm. B. Westbrooke of the other party witnesseth that Henry Morris and Elizabeth his wife for an consideration of the sum of four hundred & fifty four dollars paid to them on hand by the said Westbrooke at or before the sealing or delivering of this instrument the Devises whereof is hereby acknowledged that the aforesaid Henry Morris and Elizabeth his wife have granted bargained sold & by these presents doth grant Bargain & sell unto the aforesaid Wm. B. Westbrooke all the right title and interest which they have or hold unto a certain tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia known as the place and which John Womack used, seized, occupied and recently occupied by the heirs of said Womack contain four hundred & fifty acres situate more or less the boundary of said land as follows "Knit by Person's Union Mill pond West by the Land of Howell Harris & John A. Person Commencing at the water of said Mill pond running from thence to the Road leading from Heriot church across said pond thence along the various turns of sd Road until it reaches a small clay hill where the said Howell Harris crosses the said Road from thence to the corner between the said Harris & Persons Roads by the lands of John A. Person, H. A. James & Nathan & Thomas & East by the Lands of Benjamin Ellis & W. Hunt to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all the improvements & appurtenances thereon annexed free from the claim or claims of said the said Morris wife Elizabeth and all and every person or persons whatsoever to the only proper use & benefit of him the said Wm. B. Westbrooke his heirs & assigns for & the said Morris wife the aforesaid sum of four hundred & fifty four dollars to him and others heirs the premises & every particle or part thereof herein contained or intended to be conveyed against the said Morris & wife their heirs & assigns all and every person or persons whatsoever to the aforesaid Wm. B. Westbrooke & his heirs & assigns shall warrant defend by these presents & affix his seal the day & date above written
