This Indenture made this 14th day of December one thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Thomas Parkridge and Susannah his wife of the one part, and James & Peters of the other part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Thomas Parkridge and Susannah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two dollars to them paid by the said James & Peters the receipt whereof they the said Thomas Parkridge & Susannah his wife do hereby acknowledge and confess have granted bargained and sold unto the said James & Peters the grant Sargent and all unto the said James & Peters his heirs and assigns and certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation six acres of the same more or less beginning at the head of the house, swamp below the old mill stone Travers North to a large point a corner thence across the old Mill pond by a line of chopped trees to Sargent P Heels line thence down said Heels line to the Run of the house swamp in the machine pond thence down to said branch of said swamp to the beginning with all the Estate right title entituled and demand whatsoever of them the said Thomas Parkridge and Susannah his wife of either to the said tract or parcel of Land with the said James & Peters his heirs and assigns to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and premises to the only proper and common benefit of him the said James & Peters his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas Parkridge and Susannah his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part thereof unto the said James & Peters his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and defend by these presents IN WITNESS WHEREOF the said Thomas Parkridge and Susannah his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first written signed sealed and delivered
