Parker and Rebecca & his wife of this County of Suffolk in consideration of two hundred and twenty eight dollars in my hands paid by Lucy Parker of this aforesaid County for my interest in in the Landed estate of my father Matthew Parker which said tract is bounded as follows "North by the bound of Swamp East by the Land of Robert Wesley South by the Land of W.W.B. Langdon Estate West by the Lands of Robert Rowland and James & Peter containing four hundred and twenty two acres to the same more or less the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Lucy Parker her heirs and assigns To have and to hold the above granted premises to the said Lucy Parker her heirs and assigns forever and will the said James T. Parker and Rebecca & his wife for myself my heirs Executors or Administrators do covenant with the said Lucy Parker her heirs and assigns that I and lawfully resell in part of the above granted premises that they are free from all encumbrances; that I have a good and perfect title right to sell and convey the same to the said Lucy Parker her heirs and assigns as aforesaid until that I will and my heirs Executors and administrators shall demand and desist the same to the said Lucy Parker her heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons" In Testimony whereof I the said James T.
