

Southampton County in the Clerk's Office the 15th day of December 1848
 This Deed of Grant between Richard C Gray and wife of the first part George
 C Gray of the second part and Sarah Dudley of the third part was acknowledged
 and by said R. C. Gray and Dudley two of its parties thereto and together with the
 Certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of its wife admitted to Record
 Teste S. R. Edwards Secy.

This Indenture made the first day of August in the year eighteen hundred
 and forty eight between William M Summerville of the County of Southampton of the one
 part and Patrick Doherty of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said
 Wm Summerville agreeably to a decree of the County Court of Southampton pronounced
 at its May Term 1848 by which he was appointed Commissioner to make sale of the lands
 which still remain unsold belonging to the heirs of Silas Summerville died at on the
 first day of August after giving due notice thereof to all the same and that Patrick
 Doherty became the purchaser at fifty two and 50/100 dollars (the Receipt of which is
 hereby acknowledged) the land is known as the Britt Bayshore tract and is bounded
 by the lands of Patrick Doherty Catherine Doherty & Mary Doherty and Patrick Doherty having
 become the purchaser is to have and to hold the said tract of land with all the appurtenances
 thereto unto the said Wm Summerville as Commissioner the said tract of land
 with all the appurtenances unto the said Patrick Doherty his heirs and assigns free from
 the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever so far as he is empowered
 by the aforesaid decree of Court shall will and do warrant and forever defend
 by law provided That Witnesseth that the said Wm Summerville has hereunto set
 his hand and seal the day and year first above written Wm Summerville (Seal)

 This Deed of Bargain and Sale from Wm Summerville Commissioner to Patrick
 Doherty was acknowledged by said Summerville and a consent to Record
 Teste S. R. Edwards Secy.

This Indenture made the 27th day of September in the year of our lord one thousand
 eight hundred and forty four between Benet Branch and Emma his wife of the one part
 and Nancy Branch of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benet Branch and
 Emma his wife in consideration of three hundred dollars of lawful money of the common
 wealth to them in hand paid by the said Nancy Branch at or before the executing and
 delivery of these presents (the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargain
 and sold unto by these presents to and vend of them their bargain and sell unto the
 said Nancy Branch her heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing
 200 acres lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded on the east
 by the creek Swamp Smith next by the lands of Martha Branch on the South by George
 Branch on the West by Allen Stephenson and on the North by Edwin R. Williams
 together with all the singular houses barns buildings outhouses woods underwoods ways waters water courses
 hereditaments usufructs pastures fruitings common woods underwoods ways waters water courses
 fishing privileges profits revenues commodities advantages emoluments incidentals
 and appurtenances whatsoever in the said tract or parcel of land belonging or having
 to be any part or parcel thereof and the revenues and profits thereunto and of every part
 revenues yearly and other rents issue and profits thereof and of every part
 and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
