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 This Indenture made and entered into the 15th day of January in the year 1849.
 between Selah Ellsworth of the first part John Barham of the second part and Harrison
 P. Pope B. & H. P. Pope and Parker D. Story of the third part all of the County of
 Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Ellsworth in writing indebted
 to the said Harrison P. Pope by bond bearing date with this Indenture in the
 sum of one hundred and sixty four dollars and fifty five cents and the said
 Selah Ellsworth being indebted to the said B. & H. P. Pope by bond bearing
 date with this Indenture with interest from the 1st day of June 1844 in the
 sum of one hundred and sixty two dollars and 58/100 and the said Ellsworth
 being indebted to the said Parker D. Story by two bonds one for twenty dollars due
 1st May 1848 the other for thirteen dollars and 18/100 due 1st day of June 1848
 and the said Selah Ellsworth being willing and desirous to secure all the aforesaid
 debts and interest. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration
 of the premises and for the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by
 the said John Barham at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
 Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Selah Ellsworth he hath given
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents hath given granted bargained and sold
 to the said John Barham his heirs and assigns forever the tract or parcel of land
 on which the said Ellsworth has been bound as the Surety tract containing 380 acres
 be the same more or less and adjoining the lands of Jacob Bowers the heirs of James
 Vick and Core Vick and Henry Story also the following Negro Slaves to wit
 Man Nat and Phadim and to hold to him the said John Barham
 proper use and behoof forever upon Trust Nevertheless that the said John
 Barham shall at the request of either one of the aforesaid parties after giving at
 least twenty days notice of the time and place of sale sell for cash at public
 auction the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and its appurtenances thereto belonging
 and the aforesaid Negro Slaves (say Man Nat and Man Phadim or so much thereof
 as will be sufficient to satisfy all of said claims and interest and out of said
 proceeds first pay the expenses thereof then pay the debts due Harrison P. Pope
 B. & H. P. Pope and Parker D. Story with interest and the balance of any pay
 over to the said Selah Ellsworth or his legal Representatives and the said Selah
 Ellsworth covenant with the said John Barham that he is possessed of and a release
 for simple right in all the property hereby conveyed and that he will forever warrant
 and defend the same against himself and all other persons whatsoever Notwithstanding
 whereof we and each of us have set our hands and seals the day and year first
 written
