

This Indenture made the 27th day of April 1848 between Thomas Rogers
 & wife Rebecca of the first part William S. Schell of the second part & Bennett
 Briggs of the third part Whereas the said Thomas Rogers stands justly indebted
 to the said Briggs in the sum of one hundred & six dollars due by him & his
 wife Rebecca Rogers being willing and desirous to secure & have agreed to secure the said debt
 from all loss or damage whatever on account of the said debt by conveying the property
 hereinafter mentioned unto the said William S. Schell to be sold for that purpose
 Now Therefore This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Thomas Rogers
 for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said
 Schell the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold
 aliened conveyed & confirmed & by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the
 said William S. Schell the following property to wit all of our interest in the
 estate of Michael Ellis dead all of our household & kitchen furniture forming
 whereof huge coat & fender not cast & whole not Rent man's money with the said
 William S. Schell his heirs & assigns and to have the said property & interest
 unto the said Schell his heirs & assigns upon Trust nevertheless that if default of
 payment in the short time be made it shall be lawful in such case for the said
 Schell to sell the aforesaid interest & property to the highest bidder for cash after
 giving legal notice of the time and place of sale by advertisement & out of the money
 arising from such sale in the first place pay all expenses attending the sale &
 in the second place pay the debt due the said Bennett S. Briggs & the balance
 if any pay over to the said Thomas Rogers his heirs & assigns & the said
 Thomas Rogers & wife Rebecca will forever warrant & defend the title of the
 aforesaid interest & property against all persons whatsoever In Witness whereof

This Indenture made with interest into the 15th day of January 1849
 between S. R. Edwards of the first part & Datto of the second part and Patrick
 McRolling of the third part Whereas the said Patrick McRolling being indebted
 unto the said Datto by one Indenture dated the 9th day of July 1845
 and undertook to Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County with the
 said Edwards as certain tract or parcel of land by return of three hundred
 acres more or less being the same land Patrick said formerly owned containing
 three hundred acres more or less in trust to be sold for the purpose of paying
 the said debt and the said Datto having been paid a part of the debt for which
 the said land was bound has agreed to release and convey to the said
 McRolling the tract of land aforesaid Now Therefore the said S. R. Edwards
