The Condition of the above obligation is such that Whereas the above bound Stephen Darden is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December 1848 to continue in the said Office of Sheriff for one year next after the expiration of his first Commission. If therefore the said Stephen Darden shall well and truly collect all rents and poor rates and account for and pay the same in such manner as is by Law directed: and also all fines for fisheries and amonments occurring or becoming due to the Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer of the Commonwealth for the time being for the use of the Commonwealth in like manner as is or shall be directed in case of public taxes and shall in all things hold and faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff during his continuance thereon then the above obligation to be void and to remain in full force.
