The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound
Joseph Darden is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton
by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 1st
day of December 1848 to continue in the said Office of Sheriff for one year next
after the expiration of his first Commission: If therefore the said Joseph
Darden shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the taxes imposed
law and means of taxes due in the said County of Southampton and shall truly
account for and pay the militia fees imposed by law and accuse of militia fees
due in the said County of Southampton then the above obligation to be void unless to
remain in full force.
