

This INDENTURE made the 19<sup>th</sup> day of February one thousand eight hundred  
and forty nine between James M. Wrenn of Southampton County of the one part  
and The Wrenns Jr. of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth that the  
said Jas M. Wrenn in consideration of one dollar of Lawful Money of the  
Commonwealth to have in hand paid by the said Jas Wrenn by at or before the  
executing and delivery of this present Act Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
have bargained and sold and by these presents I doth bargain and sell unto the  
said Jas Wrenn Jr his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land lying  
and being in Southampton County on the North side of the Richmon Swamps  
containing four hundred and forty one acres by the same more or less and  
bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at a sweet burnt corner standing near  
whereas nowt thence south said corner to another sweet burnt corner  
in Balsam tree thence south west to the big branch stream south down  
said branch to Richmon swamp. thence east down said swamp to a poplar at  
corner and a few rods aft in said Balsam tree stand north along said line to  
a poplar a corner in Balsam tree and four rods aft in James M. Wrenn line  
thence west along said Wrenn line to a will oak thence south west to the common  
anwry. To hubs and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises  
to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jas Wrenn Jr his heirs and  
assigns forever. until the said James M. Wrenn himself and his heirs the said  
tract or parcel of land and every part thereof unto the said Jas Wrenn Jr his  
heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and defend by these presents. In witness  
whereof the said James M. Wrenn has hereunto set his hand affixed his seal  
the day and year first above mentioned.

it witnesseth on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year 1849 it was decreed and ordered by  
the County Court of Southampton in a certain cause then pending in its Chancery Sits  
of said County between John Kitchin and others Complainants and Benjamin Kitchin  
Defendant, that the said John Fitzhugh Commissioner appointed by said Court should at  
public auction upon the following terms to wit: to much of the purchase money as well  
as necessary to pay the expenses attending the carrying the decree into effect to be paid in  
cash the remainder to be paid in twelve months. the payment whereof to be secured by  
seals with appropriate security makes sale of a certain tract of land lying and being in  
the County of Southampton and bounded as follows by the lands of Richard Kitchin and Shadrack  
Bryant and Mary Brittle belonging to the heirs of Martha former formerly Kitchin  
& containing 66 acres having therewith the time and place of sale for the period of ten days.
