dollar (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) does by these presents give  
Bargain sell and convey unto the said William A. Rollings a certain tract  
of land situate in Southampton County bounded and described as follows  
on the north by E. Briles and John Davis land formerly belonging to the estate of  
Henry Briley late on the north west by the Indian branch on the south by  
John Cobb's line and on the east by S. Rollings and John Cobb's land  
containing by estimation three hundred and thirty one acres together with all the  
privileges and appurtenances to the said land in any way appertaining and belonging  
to have and to hold the above granted premises to the said William A. Rollings  
his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behove forever and the said William  
W. Cobb for himself his heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said  
William A. Rollings that he is lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid grantee  
privies that they are free from all incumbrance that he has good right to all and  
convey the same to the said William A. Rollings and that he will and his  
executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said William  
A. Rollings his heirs and assigns from all and every lawful demands of any  
of his claimants whereby the said William W. Cobb has brought set by hand  
and seal this the tenth day of March in the year 1849
