

Know all men by these presents that I Henry Kinderd and Lucy W Kinderd of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia for and in consideration of the Natural love and affection which I bear to Benjamin B Kinderd of the County and State aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to have in hand paid by the said Benjamin B Kinderd at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the right thereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Benjamin B Kinderd his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid and bounded by the lands of Odious Harris heirs of Brittain Bryant dead Correll Bryant Jacob Burns and others containing by estimation six hundred and forty two acres is better some more or less in the said Henry Kinderd and Lucy W Kinderd have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Benjamin B Kinderd as heirs of said ^{Benjamin} Correll Bryant his heirs forever in the said Henry Kinderd and Lucy W Kinderd do warrant and forever defend the right title &c. In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this 17th day of February 1849.

This Indenture Made this 31st day of February one thousand eight hundred and forty nine between Peter Philip John Wilson John Wren and Carl Mangum Commissioners appointed by the Worshipful Court of Southampton to sell the Lands of Nathaniel Wren dead of the one part and James M. Wren of the same County due to the other part: Witnesseth that the said Commissioners for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and sixty one dollars and five cents Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said James M. Wren the Receipt whereof the said Commissioners do hereby acknowledge and do hereby have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said James M. Wren his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcels of land situate lying and being within the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by a late survey four hundred and thirty one acres be the same more or less it being the tract of land in the North side of the Racepoint Swamp of which Nathaniel Wren died seized and possessed with all the estate right title interest claims and demands whatsoever of them
