This Indenture made the 21st day of February in the year of our Lord 1835 between Elizabeth Thomas of the first party and Clement Rochelle of the second party, both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia: Whereas the said Elizabeth Thomas for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred & twenty eight dollars and 38 cents to her in hand paid by the said Clement Rochelle at a before the making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell and confirm unto him the said Clement Rochelle his heirs and assigns: with certain tract or parcels of land lying and being in the County aforesaid and containing by estimation eighty seven acres or the same more or less, being the land which was allotted to the said Elizabeth Thomas in the division of the lands of her deceased father John Rochelle as will be more fully referred to the Report of Commissioners who made the division returned to Southampton August Court 1831: To have and to hold the same tract of land together with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Clement Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever: and the said Elizabeth Thomas doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Clement Rochelle his heirs and assigns that she the said Elizabeth Thomas her heirs and assigns will warrant and forever defend the title to the aforesaid tract of land and premises unto him the said Clement Rochelle his heirs and assigns against the claim or demand of her the said Elizabeth Thomas her heirs and assigns against the heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever: And Witness whereof the said Elizabeth Thomas hath hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and year first above written
