Dots his Executors administrators and assigns forever. And the said Patrick Dots for himself his Executors administrators the same tract of land unto the said Robert M. Dots his Executors administrators and assigns against the claims of him the said Patrick Dots his Executors and administrators and against the claims or claims of all and every other present or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by them their privates In Witness whereof I put my hand and seal this the 15th day of July in the year of our lord 1848.

And all men by these presents that I Solomon Johnson of Southampton County and State of Va. in and for the consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid by William Murfrees of the said County and State before the execution of these presents the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and assigned and do hereby bargain sell and assign unto the said W^m Murfrees all of my right title and interest both personal and Real which I am or may in any way be entitled to by the death of James Johnson and Willis Johnson who was my brother and who left this County 3rd August for Texas and has since died as I have been informed and news of (Schubert Johnson died) To have and to hold the said right to the only proper use and behoof of the said William Murfrees his heirs Executors and assigns forever and I the said Solomon Johnson do hereby for myself my heirs Executors and assigns Covenant to and with the said W^m Murfrees that I have good right full power and lawful and absolute title and authority to bargain sell and assign the aforesaid right title and interest in the manner and form aforesaid and I do hereby for myself my heirs Executors and assigns bargain sell and assign unto the said W^m Murfrees his heirs Executors and assigns forever to hold against me the said Solomon Johnson my heirs Executors and assigns all and every other present or persons whatsoever warrant and defend: In Witness whereof I write at my hand and affix my seal this 6th day of February A. D. one thousand eight hundred and forty nine.
