whom is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth
bargain and sell unto the said Sally Herring her heirs and assigns forever all that part
of land of which Thos Herring died seized known as the home tract bounded by
the Water on one side back to the other and by the lands of Jordan Spring,
William Tonkin and contains by estimation one hundred & five acres more or less
thereunto to hold the above granted and bargained premises with all and singular
the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said land
said Sally Herring her heirs and assigns forever; and the said William T. Herring
for himself his heirs or assigns unto the said Sally Herring heirs executors
and administrators hereby warrants and defendeth the title to the above named tract
of land (so far as it is outside in him as Commissioner) free from all claim or
