This Indenture made this the twenty third day of April one thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Benjamin & Cobb of the one part and Catharine M. Cobb Sarah A. Cobb and Margaret J. Cobb of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the natural love and affections which the said Benjamin & Cobb has for the said Catharine M. Cobb Sarah A. Cobb and Margaret J. Cobb the said Benjamin & Cobb has removed, devised and bequeathed unto the said Catharine M. Cobb Sarah A. Cobb and Margaret J. Cobb the tract of land lying and situate in the County of Southampton which he purchased from Jeremiah Cobb and the following Negroes to wit "Fannie Fortune Stephen Miles and one Tom and William and all the other personal property which he purchased at the sale of the property of Jeremiah Cobb and which now remains on the tract of land above mentioned." To have and to hold the aforementioned property unto the said Catharine M. Cobb Sarah A. Cobb and Margaret J. Cobb their Executors administrators and assigns for the term of five years from the date hereof: AND the said Benjamin & Cobb shall and will warrant the aforementioned property against the lawful demands of all persons whatsoever unto the said Catharine M. Cobb Sarah A. Cobb and Margaret J. Cobb their Executors administrators and assigns for the said term of five years.
