This Indenture made and entered into the 11th day of January 1849 between
 Firdling J. Mahomet of the first part William Mahomet brother of the second part and
 S R Culwilde, H J Smith, Harriet D. Moore, Pomson & Rives & W. Mahomet of the
 third part; all of the County of Southampton: Whereas the said above mentioned parties
 of the third part; have become the endorsees and securities of the said Firdling J.
 Mahomet on a certain promissory note executed by the said Firdling J. Mahomet in the
 sum of one thousand dollars bearing date the 3rd day of January 1849. Negotiable and
 payable eighty eight days after date at the Office of discount and deposit of the Bank
 of Virginia in the Town of Richmond: and whereas the said Firdling J. Mahomet of
 the first part is willing to secure and save himself the said parties of the third part
 and each of them as his said endorsees and securities on the said note; and also each of
 them as may become hereafter endorsees & securities on any note given for the amount
 of the said above mentioned debt: as well as each and every of them the said parties of the
 third part; and also any other present or persons that hereafter know who may hereafter
 become endorsees and securities on any note executed by the said Mahomet and given for
 the amount of the said note: Now Therefore this Indenture witnesseth that for and
 in consideration of the promise and for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid
 by the said William Mahomet to the said Firdling J. Mahomet the Receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged: he the said Firdling J. Mahomet has given granted bargain'd & sold
 to the said William Mahomet his heirs & assigns a certain Lot in the Town of Jamestown
 designated in the plan of said Town as No 11, also a small piece of Land lying next of
 and contiguous to said Lot commonly called the Stable Lot which Lot & piece of Land is
 the same purchased by the said Firdling J. Mahomet of Brig. Lamb; and now occupied
 by the said Mahomet as a Tavern: also one house & few acres of Land adjoining the said Town
 Lot and occupied in common therewith fronting the street, one half of which was conveyed
 to the said Mahomet by William O. Roberts, and the other half by Thomas & Sons as
