This Indenture made the 17th day of June in the year of our lord our thousand eight hundred and forty eight between Bennett S Griffin and Susan his wife and John Jayne and Eliza his wife Lucy Griffin and Micajah Thomas Griffin and Nancy Griffin Widows of Harrison Griffin dec'd of the one party; and Winston Griffin all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia; doth by their private great bargain and sale the undersay and consent and by their private bills granted bargain'd & sold unto the said Winston Griffin to him and to his heirs forever; and certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid containing by estimation twenty acres more or less more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a small black Gum standing near the east end of the Cypress Swamp a cor of George Johnson and the heirs of Thomas Decker dec'd about N 3 W 4 1/2 ps to a point a corner of George Johnson at the corner of the pond: thence N 62 E 78 ps to a black Gum a corner of Ben Hunsley standing in a line the east end of the middle branch thence down the east end of the middle branch P 4 W 34 ps to where the path crosses the branch a point of the same name thence S 0 E 20 ps to a large black Gum a corner of the heirs of Thomas Decker dec'd and Ben Hunsley standing in the junction of the middle branch and the Cypress Swamp thence up the various courses of the Cypress Swamp; to the beginning together with all houses out houses, kilns, buildings yards gardens, orchards, ways, waters and water courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have unto the said the said land and premises to him and to his heirs forever. And the said Bennett Griffin and Susan his wife John Jayne and Eliza his wife Lucy Griffin Micajah Thos Griffin & Nancy Griffin Widows of Harrison Griffin dec'd doth for themselves their heirs Executors administrators and assigns premises and grant to and with the said Winston Griffin his heirs and assigns by their private that they will warrant and forever defend all rights like claims or demands of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof: In Witness whereof the said Bennett Griffin and Susan his wife John Jayne and Eliza his wife Lucy Griffin Micajah Thomas Griffin and Nancy Griffin Widows of Harrison Griffin dec'd have hereunto put their hands and seals this day and date within written
