This Indenture made this fifteenth day of June in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty, first between John Meers
 of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and
 Orris Meers of the same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth
 that the said John Meers had in consideration of the sum of one hundred and
 twenty dollars cash in hand paid at or before the making and delivery of
 this preamble (the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and
 sold and by this preamble do bargain and sell unto the said Orris Meers
 his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being
 in the County aforesaid containing by estimation sixty two and one half acres
 or thereabouts more or less, fifty eight acres of which Land purchased by him
 of St. Clair Jaynes and his wife Anahel and inherited by his wife, taken
 from his father Jacob Barnes, and the remaining four and one half acres
 being waste Land reclaimed by him in the year one thousand eight hundred
 and fourteen all of which may be particularly ascertained by reference to
 Record and is bounded as follows (Viz.) by the Lands of Elizabeth
 McChesney Jeremiah Willford and that belonging to the estate of
 Benjamin Day &c. together with all and singular the reversion and
 reversions remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issue and profits
 thereof and every part and parcel thereof: To have and to hold the said
 sixty two and one half acres of Land with the tenements hereditaments and
 all and singular other the premises hereinbefore mentioned or intended to be
 bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of the
 rights members and appurtenances unto the said Orris Meers his heirs and
 assigns forever: And the said John Meers doth for himself and his heirs
 the said sixty two and one half acres of Land with all and singular the
 premises and appurtenances hereunto touching unto the said Orris Meers his
 heirs and assigns free from the claims or claims of him the said John Meers
 for his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall
 will and do warrant and forever defend by Law permitted: And Witnesseth
 that the said John Meers doth his hands set his hand and seal
 the day and year first above mentioned,
