

This Indenture made and entered into this 18th day of June 1847
 between Henry Sayer of the first part John Barham of the second part
 and Henry Kinderd Bond & Pope and B. & H. P. Pope of the third part,
 all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia: Whereas the said
 Henry Sayer is indebted to the said Henry Kinderd by bond bearing date
 the 2nd day of May 1847 in the sum of thirteen dollars and 75/100 also
 indebted to the said Bond & Pope by bond not for fifteen dollars and 38/100
 due and bearing said date with this Indenture another for four hundred
 and forty seven dollars dated this and the 16th of January 1843 subject to
 a credit of four hundred and seventy eight dollars and four cents subject
 to another credit of about dollars and 70/100 paid Jan^y 2^d 1849. and
 the said Henry Sayer being also indebted to the said B. & H. P. Pope by
 bond not for sixty six dollars and 10/100 due and dated the 19th day of June
 1848 another for twenty five dollars and 25/100 due the 15th of March 1847
 and bearing said date with this Indenture. and the said Henry Sayer
 being willing and desirous to secure all the aforesaid debts and interests from
 this Indenture it is hereby that for and in consideration of the premises
 and for the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the
 said John Barham at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
 the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Henry Sayer has he
 given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain
 and sell to the said John Barham his heirs and assigns forever the following
 property to wit: one Bay horse private growing crop of corn fifteen cotton trees
 and potatoes to have and to hold to him the said John Barham only proper
 and lawful forever upon Trust however help that the said John Barham
 shall at the request of either one of the aforesaid parties after giving at least ten
 days notice of the time and place of sale sell at public auction for cash
 all the property hereby conveyed or so much thereof as shall be sufficient
 to satisfy said debts and S^{ts} and out of the proceeds first pay the sum
 thereof due pay the debt of thirteen dollars and 75/100 with S^{ts} due Henry
 Kinderd and the debt of fifteen dollars and 38/100 due Bond & Pope with
 S^{ts} after which pay the other debt due Bond & Pope herebefore named with
 S^{ts} and the debts due the said B. & H. P. Pope as herebefore named and the
 balance if any pay over to the said Henry Sayer or his legal Representatives
 and the said Henry Sayer covenant with the said John Barham that
 he is possessed of an absolute for simple right in all the property herebefore named
 and that he will forever warrant and defend the same against himself and
 all other persons whatsoever. In Testimony whereof we and each of us have as
