This 25th day of June one thousand eight hundred and forty nine between Adams Peutches of the first part & John Barham of the second part and Harrison P. Pope Esq. & Henry Kindred Quirkert & Barker & Story of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia whereas the said Adams Peutches is justly indebted to the said Harrison P. Pope by bonds bearing date with their presents in the sum of fifty five dollars \$55⁰⁰ to B.C. & H.P.P. Pope by bonds bearing date with their presents in the sum of nine dollars & twenty one cents to Horace Kindred by bonds and due 25th December eighteen hundred & forty three in the sum of ten dollars and other bond due 1st day of January 1841 in the sum of six hundred dollars \$600⁰⁰ subject to a credit of four dollars \$4⁰⁰ paid 1st January 1841 also and other credit of four dollars paid 25th Jan'y 1843 and also bond due 1st day of April 1843 in the sum of seventeen dollars \$17⁰⁰ subject to a credit of three dollars \$3⁰⁰ paid Jan'y 14th 1847 to Quirkert & Barker by judgment on bonds now in the hands of John Barham in the sum of fifteen or twenty dollars To Parker & Story by judgment a bond now in the hands of John Barham in the sum of ten or twelve dollars and the said Adams Peutches being willing and desirous to secure the aforesaid debts interest and costs now this instant and without further consideration of the premises until for the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the trustee at and before the making and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Adams Peutches back given granted bargained and sold and by the presents back given grant Bargain and sell to the said John Barham his heirs and assigns forever and have 5th five broad bays and their future increase 3rd fractio[n] bays furniture and other household chais three tables 3 chairs and elegant plates 3 dishes and dozen knives & forks and elegant cups and saucers one bowl and two dishes unto me and my next & heirs for 1200⁰⁰ plus here two dozen above plates plus two sets plus your 4th door bars 3 grand bars 3 axes and wodges and all other articles of household furniture forming utensils & kitchen furniture belonging to the said Adams Peutches annually growing crop of corn cotton feeders pens potatoes &c. etc. house and lot to hold to his heirs said John Barham proper and behalf former upon trust nevertheless that the said John Barham shall at the request of either one of the parties aforesaid after giving at least ten days notice of the time and place of sale sell at public auction all the aforesaid property or so much thereof as will be sufficient to satisfy all of said debts interest and costs and out of the proceeds first pay the expenses thereof accordingly pay the debt due Harrison P. Pope & Henry Kindred Quirkert & Barker & Parker & Story and the balance if any pay over to the said Adams Peutches or his legal Representat[or] and the said Adams Peutches covenant with the said John Barham that he is possessed of and absolute free simple right in the property hereby conveyed
