Estevan W. Mafrinburg of the third party, securities. Whereas the said Manning  
& Smith and Richard & Crump have become the securities of the said W. S.  
Riddick to five bonds due Colvins Harrison Commissioner amounting in all  
about eight hundred and fifty dollars all of which are now due and  
that said Manning & Smith is also security to the said Washington S. Riddick  
on two forthcoming bonds and that Richard & Crump supposed to be now about  
four hundred and fifty dollars including interest, costs and expenses the  
other supposed to be about Ninety four dollars due Richard & Crump also on  
a bond due William J. Dabill administrator of D. Dringshoft for about forty  
dollars and a bond due John J. Mason about one hundred and fifty dollars

having granted Bargain and sold unto the said persons done your grant  
Bargain, and sells unto the said William D. Panels the following property to  
a tract of Land supposed to contain about hundred acres to the same tract of  
formerly owned by William Harrison known as Landlord and for which the first  
part named lands were given and bounded by the Land of William Baileys  
Pomeroy Cobb and Wilson Dardis and others and the following Negro slave  
wit. M'art. Alfred. M'art. Lewis and his children Thomas Dicky and others  
two miles all his household and kitchen furniture and farming implements  
having and to hold the said Real and personal property together with
