ford of the same County and State of the other party: Witnesseth that the said  
David Royal and Mary his wife in consideration of two hundred and forty  
dollars of lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid at a time  
that exceeding and delivery of what presents (the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)  
have bargained & sold by these presents the Bargain and sell unto the said Wil-  
liam Bankford his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land situate by  
and lying in the County of Southampton containing by estimation three  
hundred and thirty and six acres to the same more or less and bounded as  
follows (viz) by the lands of the called the Gray tract: Richard Williams his  
He Rolling & others like bodies with all and singular the hereditaments and  
remainders yearly and other Realty, goods and chattels known and very part and  
parcel therof. To have and to hold the said three hundred and thirty six  
acres more or less Land the plantation whereon David Royal doth now sit  
growing crop of corn, feather, peas, potatoes &c with the house buildings  
and all and singular other the premises hereinbefore mentioned or intended to be  
bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with none of these right  
members and appurtenances unto the said William Bankford his heirs and assigns  
forever: And the said David Royal and Mary his wife for themselves and  
their heirs the said three hundred and 30 1/3 acres same with all and singular  
the premises and appurtenances before mentioned with the said William Bankford
