Rollings of the other part: both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said James Dugal for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars to him in hand paid by the said Patrick H. Rollings at and before the making and delivery of this private Act Receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by this private do grant bargain and sell unto the said Patrick H. Rollings and confirm unto the said Patrick H. Rollings his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the said County which the said Benjamin Dugal received from the said of Messrs. Rollins, Riddick and bounded as follows: on the North by the Land of John Riddick on the West by the Land of William Oney and the Land of John Riddick on the East by the Land of William Oney and the Land of Capt. D. Butler & containing 20 acres but the same more or less the said Patrick H. Rollings do have and hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances and all the right title claim and interest claims and demand whatsoever of him the said
