

Pope his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit: present crop of corn, potatoes, peas, peaches & ground peas: including the four barrels corn and five bushels of sorghum allowed by law to poor debtors: one small six pipe and five shante one feather bed & furniture, one pot, one tea kettle one spider one pair tin kettles one round tin wood box, one hat one first hand plough & one pair best cups & saucers, four chairs, one table one iron stand & stove and one house. To have and to hold the above mentioned crop and property with the exception above made unto him the said his heirs and assigns forever until the said trustee Christy for himself his heirs Executors and administrators shall hereby covenant and agree to and with the said John Pope his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that he will by three private warrants and forever defend the right and title of said crop & property against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, upon special trust trusteeship to and for the following intents uses and purposes that is to say that he the said John Pope his Executors administrators or assigns may and shall at any time hereafter when he or they shall be thereto requested by either the said Uriah Christy or Olisha Pope or their Representatives make sale of the said crop and property (with the exception aforesaid) at public auction to the highest bidder for ready money after giving ten days previous public notice of the time and place of sale by three or more public advertisements in the neighborhood and out of the proceeds of such sale after satisfying all costs pay unto Olisha Pope his Executors administrators or assigns the amount of the said two loads or more and the legal interest thereon accruing or so much thereof as he may have in hand and the surplus should there be any pay to and Uriah Christy or his order: In witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto at their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written signed sealed & delivered
