 bargained and sold unto by their presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said
 William S. Herring his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation fifty acres more or less
 and bounded by the lands of Judson Sperry George D. Sperry and Arlington Butt
 known as the Sperry tract which formerly belonged to the Herring dec'd: To have
 and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with all and singular the
 appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise to the said William S. Herring his heirs and
 part and parcel thereof unto him the said William S. Herring his heirs and
 assigns forever: And the said Patrick Doherty for himself and his heirs the said
 tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before
 mentioned unto the said William S. Herring his heirs and assigns free from the claims
 or claims of him the said Patrick Doherty and his heirs shall will and do warrant
