Newton of Southampton County for and in consideration of the Natural love and affection which I bear to my son James Newton of said County, as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said James Newton at or before the recording of one dollar of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged here given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said James Newton his Executors administrators and assigns fifty acres of Land with the appurtenances situate lying and being on the north side of the flat swamp at the west end of my land lying south of Road in said County and bounded as follows, by the Land of Howell Harris and Neighbors: To have and to hold the said fifty acres of land to the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Newton his Executors administrators and assigns forever: and the said Jabez B. Newton for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the said fifty acres of Land with the said James Newton his heirs Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of him the said Jabez B. Newton his heirs Executors and administrators and against the claim or claims of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will forever warrant and defend them by these presents. This Indenture made and entered into this 1st day of September in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty three between William Harris and Eliza his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of Kottoway of the one part, and Bury Williams of the other part, Witnesseth that the said William Harris and Eliza his wife for and in consideration of the sum of forty dollars Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Bury Williams the Receipt is hereby acknowledged back granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Bury Williams to have and his heirs forever a tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation twenty five acres being more or less and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a black Oak in James Harris line and the said Bury Williams line; thence along said James Harris line to a pine in Marshes Buffers line thence along said Marshes Buffers line to a pine in said line and Nathan James line thence along said James Harris line to a black Oak in said James Harris line and William Harris line thence along said James Harris line to the first station together with all the appurtenances whatsoever belonging in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of Land and premises to have and to hold the same unto the said Bury Williams to him and his heirs forever and the said William Harris and Eliza his wife doth by these presents grant to and with the said Bury Williams that they will warrant and defend all right title claim or demand to the same or any part thereof.
