This Indenture made and entered into this 5th day of September in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty four between William Harris and Olga his wife of the County of Southampton and Norway parish of the one part: and Zachariah Doyal of the other part: Witnesseth that the said William Harris and Olga his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy eight dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Zachariah Doyal (the Receipt is her by them in hand paid) by the said Zachariah Doyal the Receipt is her by acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed unto by their several deeds grant bargain and sell unto the said Zachariah Doyal to have and his heirs forever a certain tract of Land containing by Estimation Nineteen and a half acres by the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit: beginning at a black Oak near the Road in Zachariah Doyal and William Harris line thence said Harris line to a black Gum in said Harris and Matthew Wells line thence along said Wells line to a pine in said Wells and Bury Roundup line thence along said Roundup line to a post Oak in said Roundup line thence along said line to a pine at the road in Zachariah Doyal line thence thence the Road to the first station together with all the appurtenances thence thence the Road to the first station together with all the appurtenances whatsoever belonging or in any way appertaining to the said tract a parcel of said land and premises: To have and to hold the same unto the said Zachariah Doyal to him and to his heirs forever and the said William Harris and Olga his wife do hereby in their private grant to and with the said Zachariah Doyal that they with warrant and defense all right title claim or demand to the same or any part thereof: In Testimony whereof the said William Harris and Olga his wife have herunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first above written
